I refer to your recent complaint of burglary. The matter has been recorded and will be investigated in an effort to identify the person(s) responsible.

Should you have, or obtain, any further information which may be of assistance to the investigation, please contact the investigating officer on the above telephone number quoting the crime report number.

The risk of becoming a victim of burglary again can depend on where you live, but may be reduced by taking extra precautions that make life more difficult for the burglar. In approximately 30% of house burglaries the offender simply walks in without needing to use force, particularly where the householder has left a door unlocked or a window open.

The straightforward practical advice contained in the enclosed literature may assist you in checking the level of your own home security and suggests steps that may be relevant for you to take to deter offenders in the future. A Suffolk Constabulary video is also available which further demonstrates home crime prevention measures. The video is available on loan from your local Crime Prevention Officer who can be contacted by telephoning Suffolk Constabulary Headquarters on 01473-613500.

I trust that you will find the enclosed information useful and hope that it may help to reduce crime and improve the quality of life for yourself and the community.
